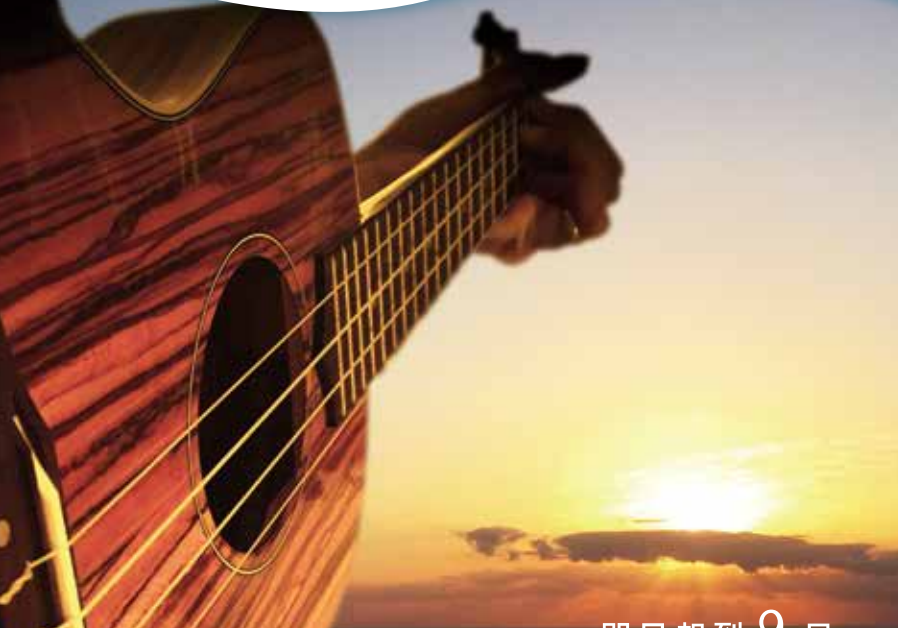

Everyone is invited to come to The Lin Family Mansion and Garden to draw lines from love poems and take home the key words written on the spot by master calligraphers.

Join the Hearts Afternoon tea shop event
Banqiao has the highest concentration of brunch/afternoon tea eateries in New Taipei City and is also a great place for lovers to go to chat sweetly over a coffee and for hipsters to read and ponder on the ways of the world.



The event includes Secretly Picking Green Onions by Night to Gain a Good Husband (in earlier times people in Taiwan believed that an unmarried women could find a good husband if she secretly picked green onions at night). Single men and women are invited to try their luck picking green onions. There is also the God Welcoming Ceremony; five gods from Xia Hai City God Temple will be invited to The Lin Family Mansion and Garden and all visitors will be invited to worship them and ask for blessing. There will also be the splendid Old Time Wedding Experience which will allow visitors to wear traditional wedding costume such as phoenix coronet and robe, long robe and Mandarin jacket etc, and, led by the acolytes of the Old Man Under the Moon, take a ride in a palanquin dressed in old-time wedding attire, experiencing the romance of a wedding from days gone by. Everyone is invited to experience a different kind of Chinese Valentine's Day at The Lin Family Mansion.



- CAR**-->Take Heping West Rd. Sec. 3 in Taipei, over Huajiang Bridge and proceed along Wenhua Rd., turn right on Minquan Rd., then make a left turn. The Garden is next to the Banqiao Second Stadium.
- BUS**-->Take bus number 264,307,310,701,702 and alight at Lin Family Mansion and Garden stop to reach Banqiao's Lin Family Mansion and Garden
- MRT**-->Take Banqiao Line (Blue line) to Fuzhong MRT Station, and leave by Exit 1. The Garden is an 8-minute walk from the station.

Lin Family Mansion and Garden – The beauty of Chinese garden structures

Venue : *The Lin Family Mansion and Garden*

The Garden has a variety of Chinese garden structures, such as pavilions, towers, halls, studies and bridges, each with a different function and style. Visit Lin Family Mansion to enjoy the beauty of a traditional Chinese garden.



CAR-->Take Heping West Rd. Sec. 3 in Taipei, over Huajiang Bridge and proceed along Wenhua Rd., turn right on Minquan Rd., then make a left turn. The Garden is next to the Banqiao Second Stadium.

BUS-->Take bus number 264,307,310,701,702 and alight at Lin Family Mansion and Garden stop to reach Banqiao's Lin Family Mansion and Garden

MRT-->Take Banqiao Line (Blue line) to Fuzhong MRT Station, and leave by Exit 1. The Garden is an 8-minute walk from the station.

New Taipei City Yingge Ceramics Museum

CAR-->Exit Sanying Interchange on National Highway No. 3, pass over Sanying Bridge (in the Yingge direction), and proceed along Wenhua Rd. to public parking lot.

BUS-->Take Taipei Bus No. 702, No. 917, No. 851, No. 981; or take a Taoyuan Bus Co. bus to Yingge.

TRAIN-->Take a commuter train to Yingge train station, the museum is a 10-minute walk from the Wenhua Rd. exit.

CAR-->No. 15 Provincial Highway: Guandu Bridge No. 15 Provincial Hwy proceed towards Bali (Longmi Road) → Zhonghua Road → Wenchang Road → Museum Rd. → Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology

MRT-->Tamsui MRT Station → Ferry → Shuttle Bus Red No. 13 Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology; or Ferry → Shuttle Bus Red No. 22, Bus No. 704 → Tianxin → Walk 5 minutes → Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology

Atayal tribal culture has no script, history traditionally been passed on by fine woven patterns. The material traditionally used in crafts were locally-sourced bamboo, wood and rattan, with daily use items mostly made, the emphasis on practical usefulness displaying the down to earth nature of the people.

CAR-->From Xindian or Yilan, take Provincial Highway No. 9, then take the Taipei-Yilan Highway or National Freeway No. 5 to reach the Museum. From Jingmei, take County Highway No. 106 past Muza, Shenkeng, and Shiding. Continue onto County Highway No. 106B. Exit for Kuolai and continue onto the Industrial Road towards Pinglin.

MRT--> Take the MRT to Xindian Station. Transfer onto the Xindian Bus Service, and take the 923 or Green 12 (G12). Get off at the stop for Pinglin Tourist Information Center (Pinglin Junior High School). The Museum is a 5-minute walk away.
