2017 Tamsui Environmental Arts Festival

Venue : Tamsui Freshwater Street ~ Tamsui Golden Marina



A boisterous stomp-the-street parade this year will be presented as a carnival. Everyone is invited to wander the streets and laneways of Tamsui, and get a taste of its unique beauty and culture. The Environmental Theater brings arts into the life of Tamsui residents, enables them to unleash their acting bug on stage, and to demonstrate the essence of the Arts Festival through close interaction with visitors on the street.

Parade- Tamsui Dance, Street Arts

The theme for the Parade this year is “Tamsui Dance, Street Arts.” The management have invited several performing troupes to participate. They include performers of Brazilian-style drummers, European folk dance, French vaudeville, African percussions, and a program by performers from 50 groups representing schools, community and business, to liven up the historic streets of Tamsui.



Environmental Theater- The Curious Journey to Wu Hu Gan

The environmentally-inspired epic theater program, “The Curious Journey to Wu Hu Gang” opens with the daintily-mannered daughter of the Mount Guanyin. The Enchanting Chinese Gardens

Venue: The Lin Family Mansion and Garden

🚗 **CAR**-->Take Heping West Rd. Sec. 3 in Taipei, over Huajiang Bridge and proceed along Wenhua Rd., turn right on Minquan Rd., then make a left turn. The Garden is next to the Banqiao Second Stadium.

🚌 **BUS**-->Take bus number 264,307,310,701,702 and alight at Lin Family Mansion and Garden stop to reach Banqiao's Lin Family Mansion and Garden

🚇 **MRT**-->Take Banqiao Line (Blue line) to Fuzhong MRT Station, and leave by Exit 1. The Garden is an 8-minute walk from the station.

Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology, New Taipei City



Virtual Reality of Exploring the "S. S. Bokhara"

Venue: Shihsanhang Museum of Amphitheater, New Taipei City/ 1F Discovery Center

The S.S. Bokhara was discovered near Gupo Islet. In 1892, the ship set off from Shanghai, but sank in a typhoon. The incident was reported at the time by the international press. Because there were crowns and large amounts of gold and silver coins dredged up from the sunken ship, it was also called the "Prince Ship". Now, you just need to pick up and put on the goggles and enjoy the virtual reality about the S.S. Bokhara.



🚗 **CAR**-->No. 15 Provincial Highway: Guandu Bridge No. 15 Provincial Hwy proceed towards Bali (Longmi Road) → Zhonghua Road → Wenchang Road → Museum Rd. → Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology

🚇 **MRT**-->Tamsui MRT Station → Ferry → Shuttle Bus Red No. 13 Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology; or Ferry → Shuttle Bus Red No. 22, Bus No. 704 → Ren'ai Rd → Walk 5 minutes → Shihsanhang Museum of Archaeology

Those Fleeting Years in Jinguashi Mine : The 120th Anniversary Exhibition

Date: Now Until 2018/02/25
Venue: Gold Museum, New Taipei City Government/Jinguashi Quanji Temple

The legendary Jinguashi Goldmine marks its 120th Anniversary this year. This exhibition consists of two narratives, "Reclamation History" and "Mountain Village Memories" through which the development and evolution of the Goldmine could be understood on the basis of historical events and memory of everyday life. The exhibition offers visitors a panoramic understanding of the historic and humanistic significance of Taiwanese goldmines from different angles.



🚌 **BUS**-->
1. Taipei-Jinguashi: Taking bus route 1062 at the Exit 2 of Zhongxiao Fuxing MRT Station via Jiufen and get off at Jinguashi.
2. Keelung- Jinguashi: Taking bus route 788 at Keelung Railway Station via Ruifang, Jiufen and get off at Jinguashi Station.

🚆 **TRAIN**--> Taking Eastern Main Line in Taipei towards Yilan, Hualien direction and transiting at Ruifang, please take Keelung bus route 1062, 788 at the Land Office next to the Police Station to Jinguashi.

Pinglin Tea Museum of New Taipei City



Tea within Tea- Tea Packaging Exhibition

Date: Now until 2018/06/03
Venue: Pinglin Tea Museum of New Taipei City/B1 Display area

The "Tea within Tea- Tea Packaging Exhibition" displays the evolution and development of tea packaging, and it's storage in the East and West throughout the ages. The exhibition is a comprehensive introduction and analysis of the history, style, function, aesthetics and marketing of tea packaging. The beauty in the packaging is also a representation of the cultural shift throughout different eras.



🚗 **CAR**-->From Xindian or Yilan, take Provincial Highway No. 9, then take the Taipei-Yilan Highway or National Freeway No. 5 to reach the Museum. From Jingmei, take County Highway No. 106 past Muza, Shenkeng, and Shiding. Continue onto County Highway No. 106B. Exit for Kuolai and continue onto the Industrial Road towards Pinglin.

🚇 **MRT**--> Take the MRT to Xindian Station. Transfer onto the Xindian Bus Service, and take the 923 or Green 12 (G12). Get off at the stop for Pinglin Tourist Information Center (Pinglin Junior High School). The Museum is a 5-minute walk away.

New Taipei City Yingge Ceramics Museum



The Taiwan Ceramics Awards 2017

Date: Now until 2018/01/14

Venue: Special Exhibition Rooms

In addition to introducing the creative process, the exhibition will focus on 6 major themes: "Early works, making tools", "Mysterious black ceramics, creating a different world in limited space", "Natural earth, exploring the magnificent of the world", "Heterogeneous intervention, reflection of materials", "Universal nature, spiritual communication" and "Traces of man in the natural landscape", showing 70 pieces of classic works, leading the audiences feel the flow of vitality image. Furthermore, especially inviting 6 outstanding ceramic artists taught by Liou, Chen-chou to co-exhibit, symbolize the endless sustainable heritage of ceramic education.



🚗 **CAR**-->Exit Sanying Interchange on National Highway No. 3, pass over Sanying Bridge (in the Yingge direction), and proceed along Wenhua Rd. to public parking lot.

🚌 **BUS**-->Take Taipei Bus No. 702, No. 917, No. 851, No. 981; or take a Taoyuan Bus Co. bus to Yingge.

🚆 **TRAIN**-->Take a commuter train to Yingge train station, the museum is a 10-minute walk from the Wenhua Rd. exit.

Wulai Atayal Museum, New Taipei City



Atayal Culture and Art

Venue : Wulai Atayal Museum, New Taipei City

Atayal tribal culture has no script, with history traditionally passed on by woven patterns. The materials traditionally used in crafts were local bamboo, wood and rattan. Most objects created were for everyday use, exemplifying the practical, down to earth nature of the people.

1. From Taipei: Taipei → Roosevelt Rd. → Beixin Rd. → Beiyi Rd. → Xinwu Rd. → Wulai
2. From Yilan: Yilan → Beiyi Rd. → Xinwu Rd. → Wulai

🚌 **BUS**--> Take Xindian Bus No.849 : Qingdao East Rd. → Roosevelt Rd. → Xindian City → Quchi → Wulai Main Station

🚇 **MRT**--> Xindian Line: Go to Xindian Station → then take a Xindian Bus No.849 (Taipei -Wulai route) → Get off at Wulai Main Station
